

# Split Personality Type



**STEP 1:** Type a capital letter in a text frame in a font of your choice. A thicker, bolder, heavier font will work the best. Increase the point size as desired. In our example, the large capital letter “D” is in the font Impact. In a separate text frame, the letters “ivide” are created.

**STEP 2:** Click on the large capital letter text frame with the Selection tool and convert the text to outlines (Type > Create Outlines).

**STEP 3:** Create the headline text in a separate text frame, assigning both a font and point size as desired, and position over the capital letter. In our example, the headline text “Math Club to conquer and” is used.

**STEP 4:** Select the headline text with the Selection tool, and copy it (Edit > Copy). With the headline text still selected, now create a duplicate of the text that is positioned over the original with Edit > Paste in Place.

**STEP 5:** Now select the duplicate headline text using the Text tool. Open the Swatches Palette, and select Paper (white) to change the type’s appearance.

**STEP 6:** Next, cut the duplicate headline text frame (Edit > Cut).

**STEP 7:** With the Direct Selection tool, click on the large capital letter. Then, use Edit > Paste Into to paste the white text inside the letterform.

**STEP 8:** Select the original headline text and use Object > Arrange > Send Backward to position it behind the duplicate text, if necessary.

**STEP 9:** Select all parts of the headline design and group them (Object > Group).
